



Vajolet is an early florican variety (~15 days compared to Tulameen). Its strong points surely are its good rusticity and its high yield. The structure of the plant is characterized by short laterals, that grow regularly along the cane, and this peculiarity leads to a fast and easy harvest. The fruits have a regular shape and a great size. Their aromatic and intense taste is greatly welcomed by the market, especially when it comes to direct sales.
